Pursuant to Section 551.072, the Pharr Economic Development Corporation may convene in a closed, non-public meeting to discuss any matters related to **real property and deliberate the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property as such would be detrimental to negotiations between the Pharr Economic Development Corporation and a third party in an open meeting.** The Pharr Economic Development Corporation and its attorney may also discuss such issues with the appropriate staff so as to obtain necessary and relevant information so that such discussion is informative and developed.
